Within the scope of the master's thesis, the topic of inner-city decline in Hamburg's city center was analyzed and concepts with innovative technologies for revitalization were elaborated. Particular attention was paid to the aspects of e-commerce and the pandemic as a catalyst.

Bildungsboulevard

In the interdisciplinary draft with upcoming teachers, a new inclusive school in the area between Neugraben and Neuwiedenthal, which covers the preschool and elementary school, was conceptually developed. In addition to the pedagogical concept, the focus is on the challenges of integration into the neighborhood, the promotion of sustainable development and the creation of a place of learning and living with equal opportunities.

TRANS.Border

October 2015 – August 2016 / HafenCity University Hamburg

TRANS.Border is a project in which approaches to solutions for the Kleiner Grasbrook, an area south of the Elbe, have been developed. Currently, most of the land is used for industrial purposes, making it unattractive and, despite its central location, inaccessible to the public. The concept is to combine a hybrid building with uses such as education, sports, gastronomy and temporary living on the site opposite the Elbphilharmonie concert hall. In order to be able to access the area, a dock is also being considered.
